(CRISIS CENTRE/SHELTER)

Krisesenteret is a low threshold offering, and it is not necessary with a referral. We have a duty of confidentiality.

WE OFFER

24-hour phone line

We are available 24-hours each day.

Day visit

We offer support, advice, and guidance, and help to contact various relevant services.

Safe housing

Krisesenteret offers housing in the critical phase. The housing is free of charge.

Ongoing support after you leave the shelter

We offer ongoing support in the form of conversations over phone, day-visits and/or homevisits after a stay at Krisesenteret.

Outward business

Krisesenteret offers information and training to other help services, the public, and public authorities.
